### Instructions for New Sportsystems

the programme should be downloaded onto your computer. Once on, Meet organisers using the new version of sportsystems will be able to e mail you one file which you can use to complete your entries, and e mail back. **The new version is significantly easier and quicker to use.**

You will not need to look up your swimmers details dates of birth etc as one of the first things you will do with the new programme is download all of the swimmers in your club from the ASA. Obtaining times is also much easier because once you have selected the swimmer to enter the times will also be imported from the British swimming rankings with one click of a button. ASANER championships will use this new programme as will county championships this link takes you to a short video (5 minutes) which explains how to use the programme [http://bravo.uk-noc.net:8080/SPORTSYS\\_Entry20](http://bravo.uk-noc.net:8080/SPORTSYS_Entry20) it may be easier if you download this video for future reference.

All clubs will receive the entry files and information via email. Please note that in the Senior/Junior Gala, **a junior swimmer must be UNDER 16** on February 7<sup>th</sup> 2010.

A draft program will be published on this web site [www.yorkshireswimming.org](http://www.yorkshireswimming.org) very soon after the closing date for entries. Please check this, as the master program will be processed about a week later and sent to the printers.

Entry Fees are, £4 for individual and £12 for Team entries and £25 for Poolside passes.

A Yorkshire S.A. Handbook will be issued with all Poolside passes.

With the new version of Sportsystems it automatically checks swimmers entry times against the qualifying time, when it is correct the entry times change to green if it is outside the time it changes to yellow. Therefore for the program not to reject swimmers all times should be green.. Therefore there will be no refunds of entry fees for rejected entries, as they should not have been entered in the first place.

**NOTE** All entries must be sent via their club's Championship Secretaries. I will not accept individual Entries.

Also please **don't send entries by recorded or special delivery**. These usually arrive late as there is not always anyone in to receive them, and someone has to get up early and go to the delivery office to collect them. All that is required is a proof of posting. This does not cost you any extra. I always contact the clubs if I have not received their entries in time.

I can then send you a draft copy of each program as soon as the entries are processed. I usually send a copy of the results as well, also any latest news and information.
